LEONARD J. BUCK GARDEN Reached Capacity

Put on your walking shoes and join us for a 1.5 hour guided walking tour at one of the premier rock gardens in the eastern United States. The nearly 100-year-old 33-acre alpine and woodland gardens have reached a breathtaking point of maturity. The fall foliage should be beautiful!. Admission \$10.

Thursday, October 24, 2023, Day Trip to New York City – High Line and Little Island

POST-CONFERENCE EXCURSION Reached Capacity

Depart hotel at 8:30 AM via carpool (about 15 minutes) to the NY Transit train station, Convent Station, NJ. Round trip train tickets are \$24.50 per person. Tickets may be pre-purchased online or at a kiosk at the train station). Parking at the station is \$5.00 per car. The train trip is about 1.5 hours to Penn Station, NYC. Meals, etc. are on your own.

After arrival, there is a 15-minute walk to Hudson Yards (shopping, restaurants, restrooms, etc.) where you can catch a glimpse of the iconic Vessel. The 31st Street entrance to the High Line is also here. Access to High Line and Little Island is free.

From here, you are on your own to enjoy the High Line and Little Island as well as many other points of interest in the area. You may walk south on the High Line, exiting at 14th St. to see Little Island.

You will be provided with an information sheet with restaurant recommendations, as well as other points of interest and shopping in the area.

We will meet between 4:00 – 4:30 PM to catch our train back to NJ.

If you prefer to return to NJ earlier, please let the tour organizer know so that she is aware of who is and is not planning to return to NJ with her.
